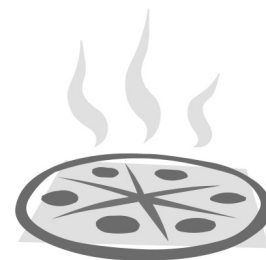


Scenario guidelines — Pizza please!

Welcome to *Pizza please!* the pizza house with a difference. Not only can you choose all your own ingredients, you can choose how much of the pizza they go on! Perfect for sharing – you like tomato, I like mushrooms, no problemo!

Or if you want it all for yourself, that's no problem either – just say what you want and we'll put it on the top, pronto!



Pizza Please!

Rules for making pizzas

- Simple – always give customers what they want!
- Create a small model of your pizza on paper to show what it would look like.

Calculating costs

- Different pizza bases cost different amounts.
- Use the *Ingredients charts* photocopiable to calculate the costs.

Example

- A customer would like a small pizza, half covered with mushrooms and half onions.

One small pizza	=	£6
$\frac{1}{2}$ mushrooms	=	£2
$\frac{1}{2}$ onions	=	£2
Total cost of pizza	=	£10

- Use this fraction pizza as a guide to help you make your own pizzas.
