# Two types of pronoun

There are different types of pronoun. The two main types are:

**personal pronouns:**  
pronouns that stand in place of a person or thing ('me', 'I', 'you', 'it')



and



**possessive pronouns:**  
pronouns that show someone owns something ('mine', 'yours', 'ours').
