The hippopotamus

The hippopotamus is a large herbivore that lives in Africa. Its name means 'river horse'. Hippos have some similar features to pigs, but in fact they are more closely related to whales and dolphins!

Living together

Hippos live in pods with one bull male in charge of many female and young hippos. They need to be near water all the time: they spend most of the day keeping cool in the water and mud. They can stay underwater for up to 5 minutes. They leave the water each night to graze on grasses.



Fast runners

Despite their short legs and large barrel-like bodies, hippos are fast runners and can charge at an amazing 30 kilometres per hour.
