DESIGN A HAT LIKE JIGGLES THE ELF'S!

In the story we meet Jiggles, a grumpy but lovable elf who just wants to ride in Santa's sleigh! Design your very own elf hat, complete with ears. Simply cut out the shapes on the next page and follow the instructions below.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR ELF HAT

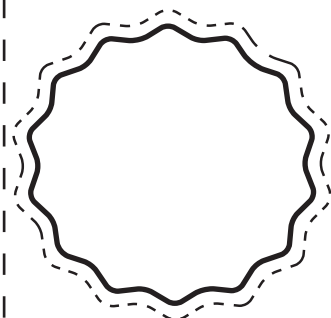
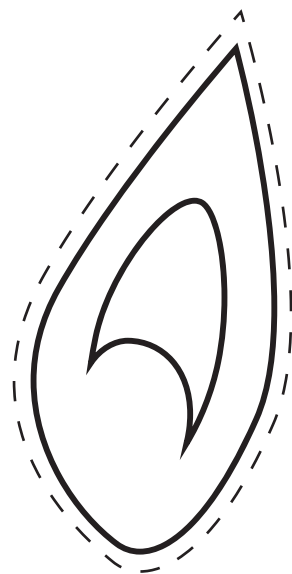
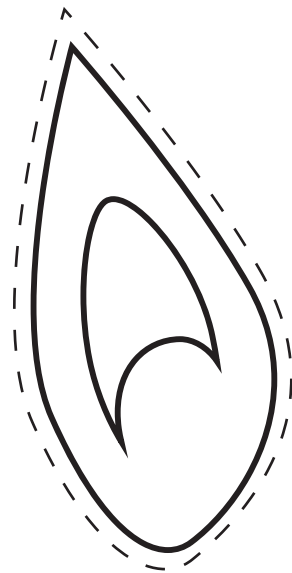


1. Start by cutting out and colouring in all the shapes on the next page – make your elf hat as fun and festive as possible!
2. Hold your rectangle lengthways and take the top two corners. Fold the two corners towards each other so you're left with a triangle.
3. Glue or staple the two sides together so you're left with a cone shape – this will be your hat!
4. Then, take your two ears and glue or staple them to the side of your hat.
5. Finally, glue or staple your circle to the top of your cone – this is the bobble for the top of your hat!

TIP!

If you want to make a Santa hat instead, just leave off the ears and use a cotton ball as your bobble!
