

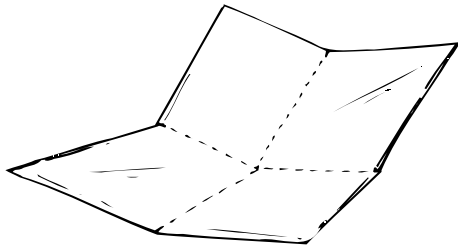
## Example 1: How to make a windmill

### You will need

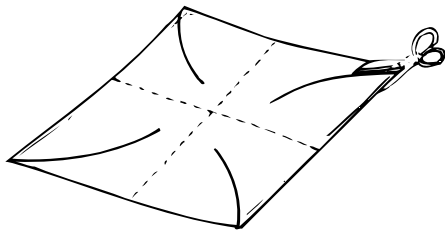
- a piece of stiff paper, 20cm square
- a pin or a long drawing pin
- a length of thin wood or bamboo
- a small bead
- glue
- scissors
- a pencil.

### What to do

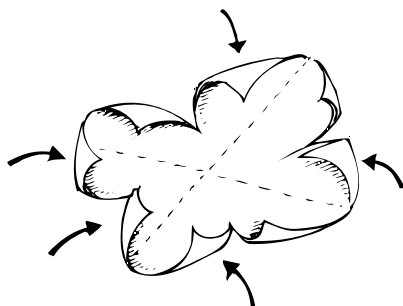
1. First, fold the paper in half. Then fold it in half again the other way to find the middle.



2. Draw four curved lines as shown in the diagram below. Cut along each line.



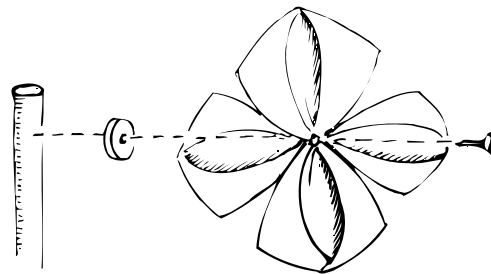
3. Next, fold in each of the corners. Glue them over the middle.



4. Let the glue dry. Then make a hole in the middle of the windmill.

5. Now carefully push the pin through the hole. Then place the bead on the end of the pin.

6. Push the pin into the wood. You may need an adult to help. Make sure the windmill can move freely.



7. Finally, blow on the side of your windmill or hold it in the wind. Watch it go round.
